



DATA PROTECTION STATEMENT

You are, no doubt, aware of changes to legislation, on 25th May, affecting the way organisations collect, process and store your personal data and what they are allowed to do with it. Stratford Thunderbirds would like to clarify the data it needs regarding our players, parents, committee members, team managers and other volunteers, as well as what we do with it and why. We also feel it is important to let you know what we don't and won't do with your data.

What we need and why?

In order to play for any Stratford Thunderbirds netball team, a player needs to be registered with the 'All England Netball Association'. In order to register a player with AENA we need to collect the player's name, address and date of birth and enter this into the AENA database.

In order to play in a competitive league, we need to register a player with each league as part of a team. In order to league register a player we need to share their name and AENA affiliation No.

In order to organise training, matches and keep you informed of club matters (e.g. awards evenings or other club administration) we need to collect the name and contact details i.e. email address and telephone numbers of at least one parent or legal guardian. Stratford Thunderbirds do not directly contact junior players (under the age of 18 years old) directly.

We do need to share your personal information with key people within the club in order for us to operate. For example – The treasurer in order to issue training invoices, the team managers in order to select players. This is kept to a minimum. Our contact list is regularly updated and distributed by the Club Manager with new additions, updates and deletions. To be prepared for all eventualities, our coaches and team managers will need to know any medical conditions that may affect a child under their supervision.

What we would like to do and why?

There may be netball related information, not directly related to Stratford Thunderbirds, that we think it would be interesting or beneficial to share with you from time to time. For example – holiday camps, special discounts. We would like to continue to do this.

What we won't ever do?

We will never share or sell your personal information with people or organisations outside of Stratford Thunderbirds Netball Club.

The club is actively scrutinising our procedures for obtaining, storing and distributing data. A new policy will be prepared, distributed and displayed on our website, once our executive committee have had a chance to finalise it. In due course, new consent forms will be circulated to coincide with new affiliation and memberships applications this summer.
